There will be a few project proposals available for you to pick

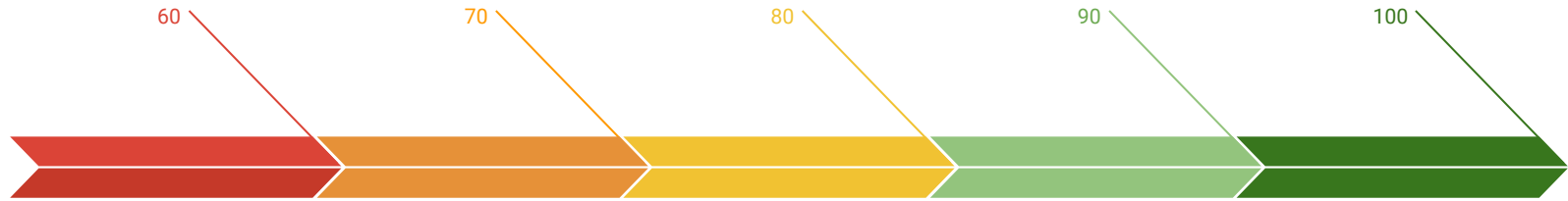

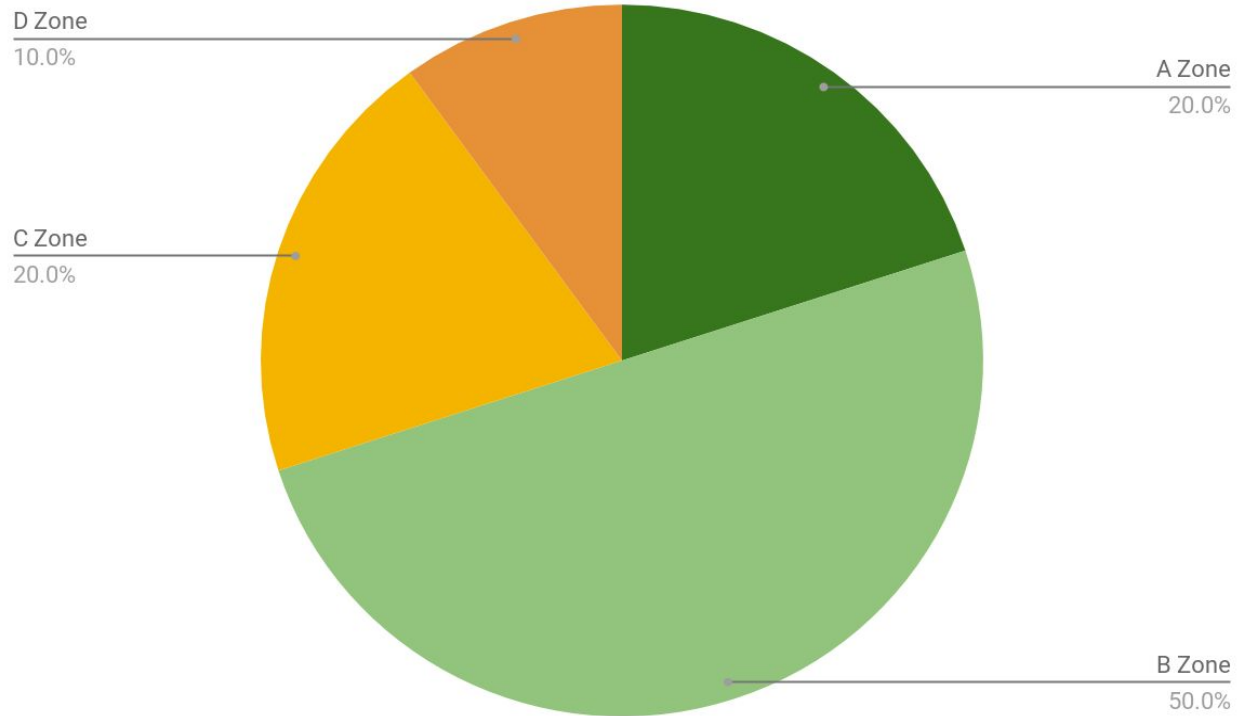

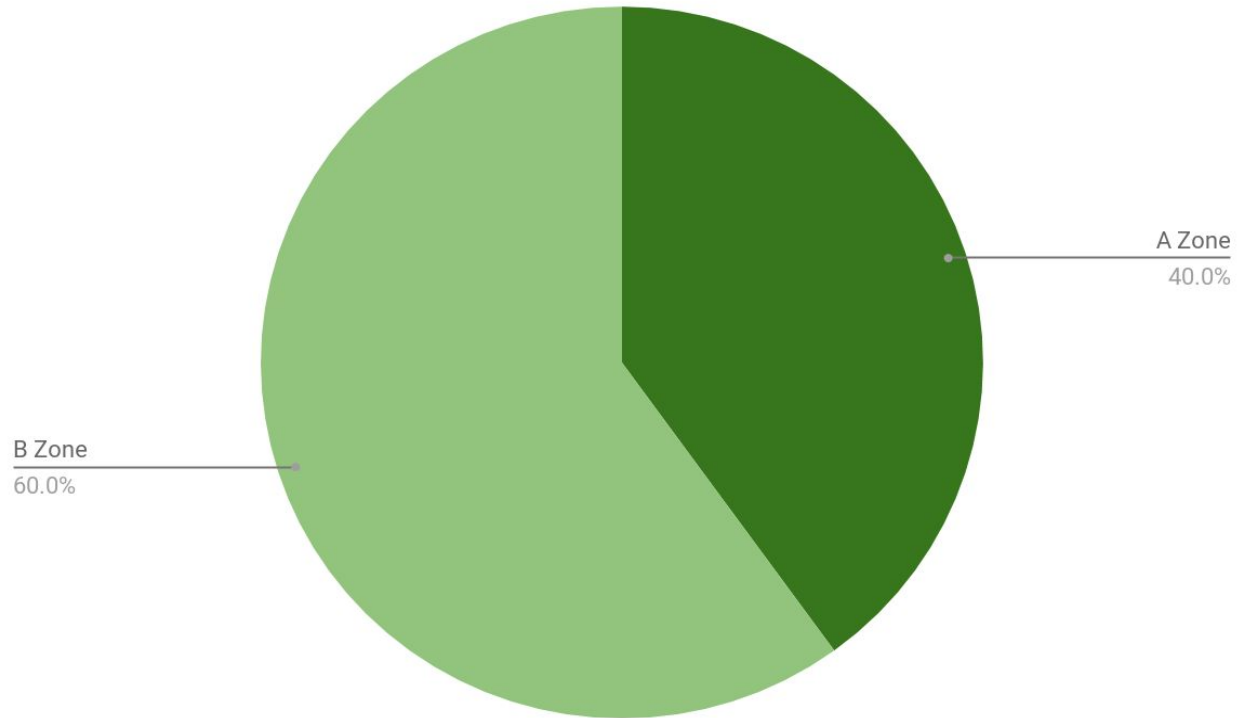
