<b>2.2</b>	user navigates to the previous page of results, if any
<b>2.3</b>	user navigates to the next page of results, if any
<b>3.1</b>	user clicks on a results link, and is taken to that entry's page
<b>3.2</b>	user navigates away from the page without following any linked results
